Summary of the Event:

In its pursuit for excellence in academics, School of Biosciences organized Peer Enrichment Talk Series on a continuous basis. Such type of activities generally focuses on enhancing and developing academic standards by engaging the individuals in high level of discussion with their peers. At the same time, it helps to develop interpersonal skills. In this reference, Dr. Tanushri Chatterji, Assistant Professor, School of Biosciences delivered her talk on **“Metabolomic study in body fluids for differentiation of meningitis in adults: A pilot study”** and was attended by her peers in faculty of Biosciences.

Dr. Tanushri conducted her study at Dr Ram Manohar Lohia Institute of Medical Sciences and Centre of Biomedical Research, Lucknow. The study was ethically approved by the Institutional Ethics Committee (IEC 14/11). In the tenure, 115 subjects were enrolled. The study focused on the differentiation of bacterial meningitis and tubercular meningitis with

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control subjects in adults using the body fluids (CSF, serum and urine). Initially, she presented the clinical manifestations associated with the infection and bottlenecks regarding diagnosis of the disease. Therefore, the study was designed with an attempt of appropriate and timely treatment regimen.

The study attempted to observe the variation in the metabolic profile, that occur in serum and urine along with CSF in adult subjects using ^1H NMR spectroscopy. Primarily, microbiological assessment was performed by culture and sensitivity, isolation and identification of bacterial species using manual as well as automated techniques and biochemical tests were performed.

Further, followed with NMR based metabolomics and multivariate analysis. Using this approach, she identified small molecular weight metabolites that affect specific biological pathways, metabolic derangements was observed and made attempts to explore their utility in clinical diagnosis.

The statistical analyses performed on the NMR data set of the three bio-fluids collectively identified 3-hydroxyisovalerate, lactate, glucose, formate, valine, alanine, ketonic bodies, malonate and choline containing compounds (choline and GPC) as significant metabolites among cases vs. control group.

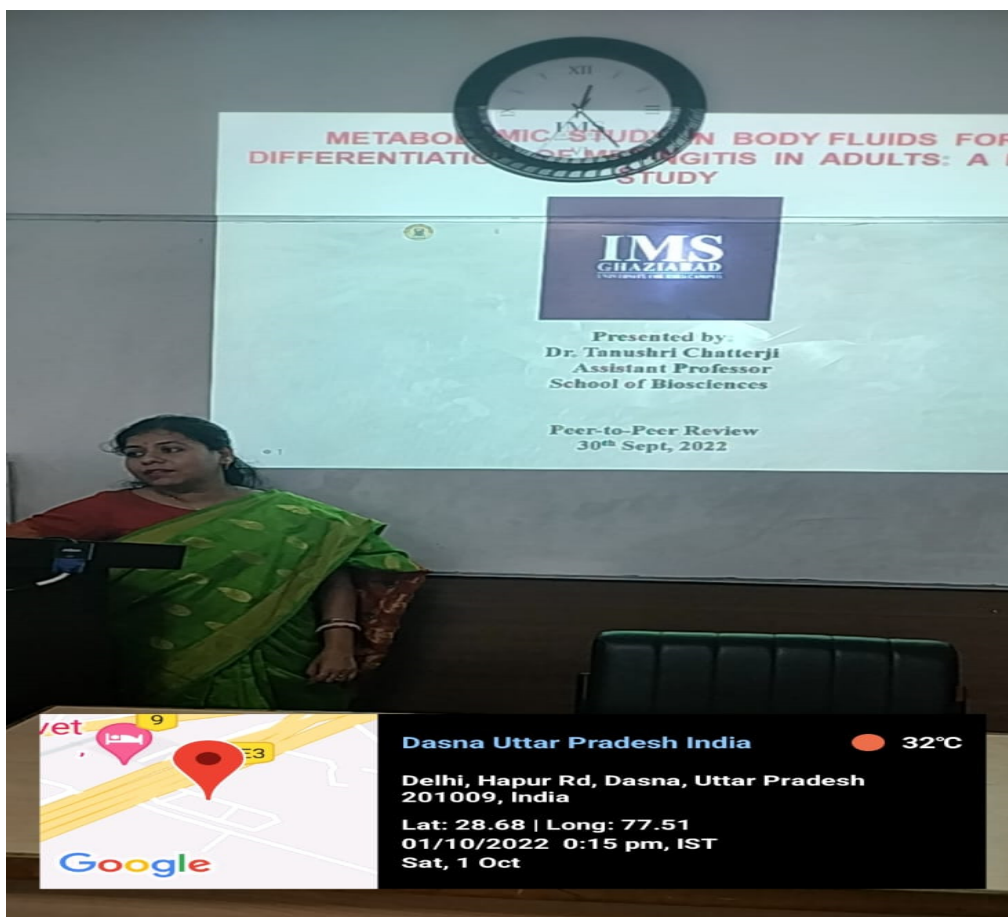
Learning Outcome: The peer enrichment series was highly informative and showed novel means that advocates integrated platform for rapid and accurate NMR based metabolite identification on meningitis cases. This pilot study demonstrated the potential for a metabolomic differentiation of bacterial and tubercular meningitis in adults using urine as a bio-fluid. Though, it further requires validation on a larger sample cohort.

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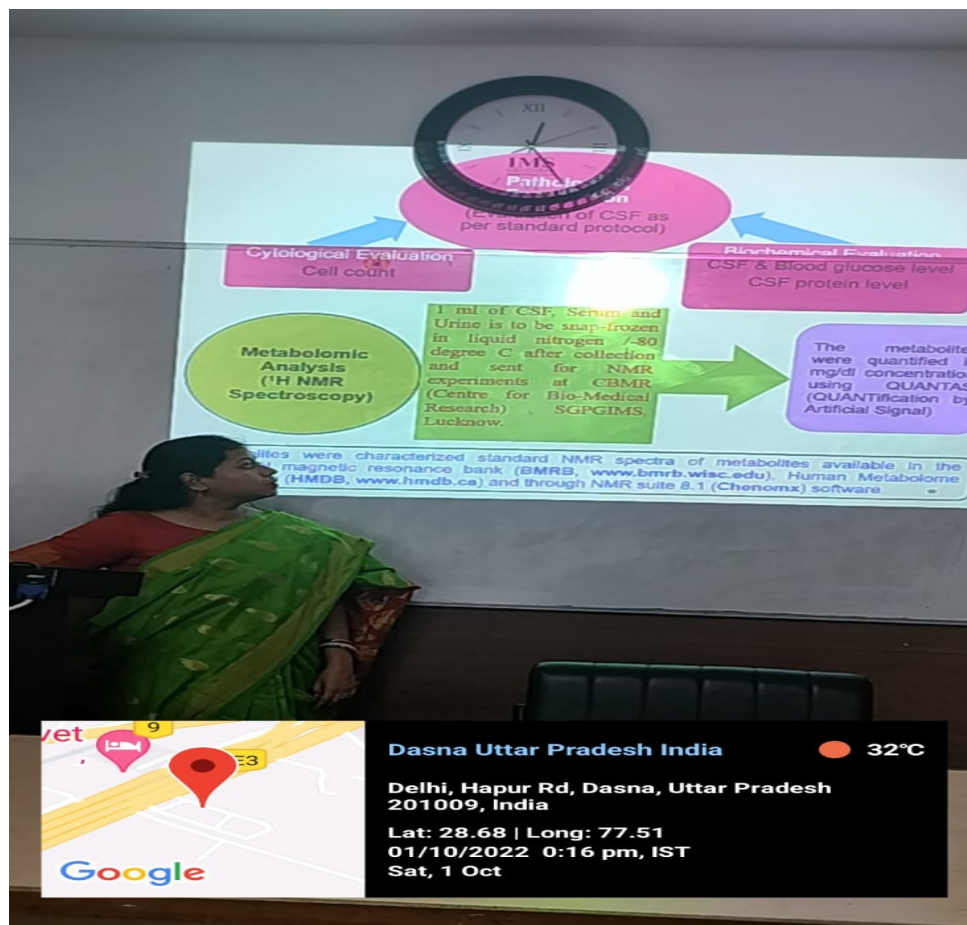

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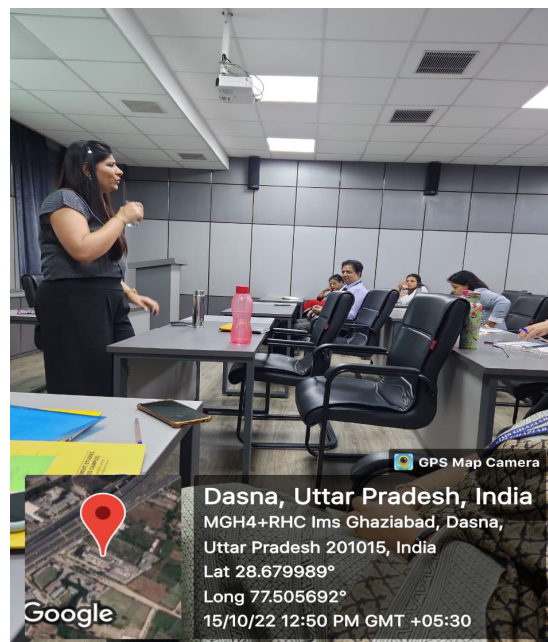
developing the budget, budget constraints, pilot study, visualising the research outcomes that the researcher needs to calculate.

Summary of the event- School of Journalism and Mass Communication of IMS Ghaziabad University Courses Campus organized a Peer Enrichment Session on “ *Mastering the Art of Radio Presentation* ” Assistant Professor Khursheed Alam conducted the session and explained all the details about radio presentation, he shared his skills and took an interactive session as he talked about the pronunciation ,diction and the presentation of the particular word during communication .He talked about the Categories of Presenters , Requirements for a Presenter , Script for Presentation and Do’s and Don’ts While Presenting a Programme. Prof. Alam told the peers that in our day to day communication and conversation, facial expressions and body gestures add a lot of meaning to the spoken words, thereby helping in understanding and adding more impact to the message. But a radio presenter does not have the visual support of such facial expressions and body movements during communication, as listeners cannot see him/her, and therefore one has to put more efforts and creativity into the art of rendering the speech to make it memorable and impactful. For our understanding, presentation broadly means packaging of the content in a radio programme and technique means art, method or procedure for attractive and effective presentation. Radio being a medium of sound, radio presenters should possess a pleasant, good quality voice, command over the

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language/dialect of broadcast, good diction and flawless pronunciation as well as confidence and flow in speaking. They should have what is called ‘the gift of the gab’, meaning ‘the ability to speak with eloquence and fluency’. He has explained the importance of creativity and an effective presentation. The session was hugely interactive as the faculty members posed a lot of questions.

Learning Outcome:

At the end of the session, he shared his radio experience with the faculty members. All in all, it was a great learning experience for all.

Aim of the study: The main objective of my research work was to study the size dependent toxicity of TiO₂ and ZnO NPs in comparison to their bulk component in *C. elegans*. *C. elegans*, a free-living soil non-parasitic nematode, with well-defined genetic tools is an excellent candidate for ecotoxicological studies for a wide range of environmental toxicants.


