#### Summary of the event-

Department of Journalism and Mass Communication conducted a guest lecture for the BAJMC students "Gender Sensitization" on 19 February 2024 from 10:30 pm to 12:00 pm at the Mini Auditorium. The objective of the session was to get an in-depth understanding of what gender sensitization is and the need for building awareness around gender equality.

#### **Learning Outcome:**

The students got an in-depth understanding of what gender sensitization is and the need for building awareness around gender equality. They also understood






the importance of gender sensitization with equal representation of male and female staff and students.




